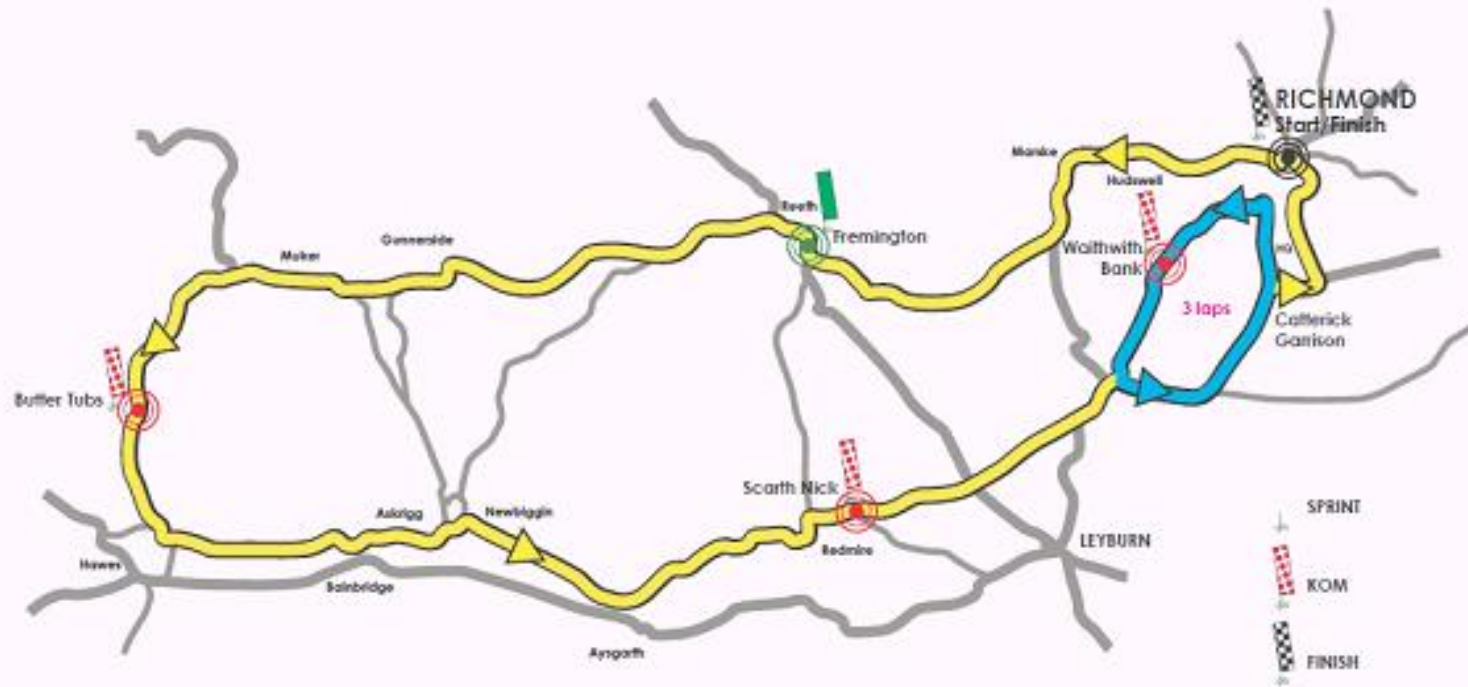

# GRAND PRIX RICHMOND



## Introduction

Welcome to the finale of the 2011 British Cycling Premier Calendar Elite road race series. The event will see up to 120 of the UK's top riders tackling an 82 mile course, starting and finishing in Richmond Market Place. The route of the 2011 event follows a 50 mile loop up Swaledale, featuring the 300m, 2 mile climb of the Butter Tubs pass, returning down Wensleydale to complete three 10 mile laps of the gruelling Waithwith circuit before the final run back to the Market Place.

The inaugural event in 2007, held on Spring Bank Holiday Sunday as part of the Richmond Cyclists' Meet, was a great success despite the 7°C, strong wind, rain and hail. In 2008, the move to September with quieter roads enabled the organisers, Richmond Cycling Club, to use the spectacular extended route. Glorious autumn sunshine in 2008 and calm conditions in 2009 and 2010 were a welcome contrast to 2007. This same course is being used again for the 2011 event with the traditional KOM competition over 3 climbs preceded by a Sprint at Fremington.

Whatever the weather, the race will be tough and is sure to provide a worthy winner. The 2007 and 2008 events were both won by Yorkshire-man Russ Downing, now riding for Team Sky and the 2009 event was won by Alex Dowsett, also with Team Sky and the 2010 event won by Kristian House, returning this year with Rapha Condor Sharp. The series is more open than in previous years and is being contested by a number of top teams all of whom are present on the race.

During the race, there will be a number of displays in the Market Place and the British Cycling Go-Ride team will be on hand to organise skill based cycling events for the youth categories (U16's). Refreshments are available in wide variety of outlets in and around the Market Place.

The event will be televised by Cyclevox for broadcast by British Eurosport.
